

### From the Pastor's Desk

We are going back into the sanctuary! Thank you for your responses to the recent survey asking for your opinion about when to resume worship in the sanctuary. The overwhelming response was "now!" Mark your calendar, May 9, Mother's Day! We will return to a 9:00 am blended worship and an 11th Hour contemporary worship.

Under the current county guidelines, we will have no more than 250 people in the sanctuary (half of the seating capacity of 500), everyone will be required to wear a mask, and temperatures will be taken at the door. We will be using every other pew and respecting appropriate safe -distancing requirements.

I want to thank everyone who made worshipping under the tent possible. Beginning with those who built the outdoor chancel, ran the power, hung the lights and decorated our worship space. Then the weekly set-up crew, arriving before 7:00 am to ensure there was enough time to get everything ready and then staying after worship to take everything down and put it away. Our tech folks are amazing, cameras, sound, streaming. They created a whole new system to provide worship both under the tent and in homes. Finally, I want to thank those who faithfully prepared the bags for Communion Sundays and the ushers who often had to brave the elements.

I also want to thank Carol Morain and Children's Ministries for all the creative effort in providing Sunday School at home this past year. It has not been easy! The plan is to keep the tent up for the foreseeable future in case the need arises to move back outside. Let's hope there isn't a need!

Looking forward, Saturday May 1 it's **Sidewalk Serenadez**. Great music from the decades live on the front lawn. Bring your lawn chair and appetite, food trucks will be on hand. Please RSVP at fpcgh.org/musicinmay. **Pentecost** is on May 23, get out your red attire. We have a lot to celebrate!


### Children's Ministry

## **Finance**

### 2021 Per Capita

Every year our budget includes money to cover our congregation's share of the administrative costs of being a part of the Presbyterian Church (USA). An individual congregation's share is calculated on its total membership. This is called "Per Capita." This year the per capita is \$37.18 per member or \$74.36 per couple. There is a blue Per Capita offering envelope located in your box of offering envelopes. The Per Capita assessment covers overhead cost of our Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly. You can also make your Per Capita payment thru

our web page utilizing the Online Giving feature at www.fpcgh.org/donate or use the QR code.
